January 23, 2018

The program audit for IDA grant is complete and went very well. A couple of minor issues were noted that will be rectified by the end of the year.

TMCS received a "C" on the published North Carolina School Report Cards. The rating system is largely based on EOG scores, with 80% being based on proficiency and 20% based on growth.

Even with days missed for weather, TMCS still has 55 extra instructional hours left, so there are no current plans for makeup days.

grades are offered, in the maximum number of grades offered by the charter school." A motion to approve was made by J. Ann, seconded by Tanya. All were in favor; none opposed. Motion carried.

The board accepted the resignation of board members Amy Johnson and Collette Summit.

The board voted to approve Jeanette Butterworth as a new board member. A motion to approve was made by Rick, seconded by J. Ann. All were in favor; none opposed. Motion carried.

With no further business, public comments, or board member observations, a motion to adjourn was made by Rick, seconded by J. Ann. All were in favor; none opposed. Motion carried. Meeting was adjourned at 7:40 p.m.
